Project Overview

The goal of the Assessment is to identify assets vulnerable to sea level rise on both the San Mateo County bayshore and coastside, determine types of impacts, issue initial recommendations on adaptation measures, and improve flooding and sea level rise mapping. The project is funded by the Coastal Conservancy. ARCADIS Consulting is conducting the technical study. For more information, visit <http://seachangesmc.com>.

What is the Technical Working Group?

The Technical Working Group (TWG) is comprised of individuals with a working knowledge and familiarity with the physical location, surrounding environment, proximity to sea level rise associated risks, and the operation of key assets in San Mateo County. Such assets may include: wastewater treatment plants, pumping facilities, electrical substations, hospitals, schools, transportation infrastructure, and natural resources.

- TWG members will help provide data, information on vulnerable assets, and details on any existing sea level rise efforts. Members will also review work products.
- The TWG will meet three times during the project. The next meetings are tentatively planned for December 2015 and February 2016.
